Site is, situated in the Lesser Caucasus in central Georgia, southwest to the nation's capital of Tbilisi and mainly is covered by Borjomi-Kharagauli National Park, which is one of the largest national parks in Europe. The total area of the park is 5,300 square kilometres. Its particular uniqueness is diversity of geographical and ecological zones, landscapes, historical monuments and rich flora and fauna. The site extend from forests to the Alpine zone. The forest includes a wide variety of plant species; reputedly almost two thirds of those found in the entire country. Borjomi site is also known for its animal life.
